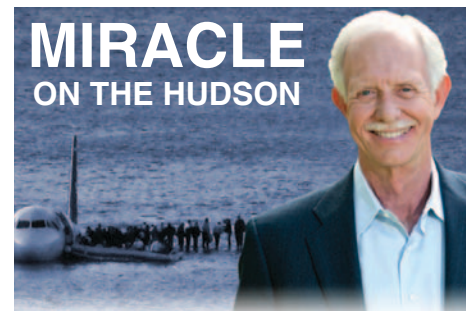

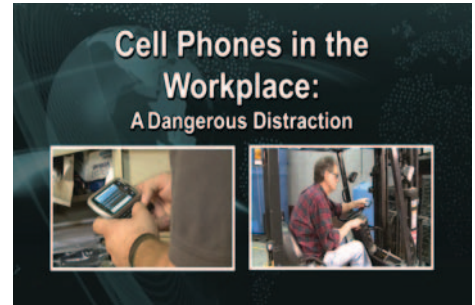
Protecting Our Sight
